

Blue Dog Dance 2015-2016 Dress Code

Dress code is important to the instructor and the students as well. Appropriate class attire facilitates the teaching of proper alignment of the body, while helping students to create unity by reducing distractions. Wearing specified dance attire in class is essential for the proper development and safety of the dancer.

Creative Dance

Girls: Pink leather ballet shoes, pink tights, pink leotard, hair neatly pulled up off the face and neck, *No skirts. No jewelry.*

Boys: Black or white leather ballet shoes, athletic type shorts, white tee shirt tucked into shorts.

Pre-Dance, Pre Ballet/Tap and Ballet/Tap

Pink leather ballet shoes, Mary Jane style tap shoes (Velcro closure is preferred), pink tights, any color plain leotard. Hair neatly pulled up of the face and neck into ponytail, braid or bun.

No skirts. No jewelry.

Ballet

Pink leather ballet shoes, pink tights, any color leotard, hair neatly pulled up off the face and neck into ponytail, braid, or bun. *No skirts. No jewelry.*

Tap

Comfortable street or dancewear that is easy to move in. Mary Jane style tap shoes for Tap Level 1, Oxford style tap shoes for Tap Level 2 and up.

Jazz

Leotard with jazz pants, leggings, capris or dance shorts with tights. Form-fitting long camisole or tank top optional with teacher approval. Jazz shoes. Hair pulled up and off face and neck.

Lyrical/Contemporary

Leotard, leggings, jazz pants, capris or shorts with tights. Jazz shoes, ballet shoes, or "foot undies" (please check with instructor for recital shoes) hair pulled up and off face and neck.

Hip-Hop

Loose, comfortable, athletic type clothing. Sneakers for class are to be clean and worn ONLY in the studio. Shoes worn in from the outside will not be allowed on the dance floor. Please have a separate pair for entering and leaving the dance floor.

Acrobatics

Leotard and shorts.
