BLUE DOG DANCE DANCE PROJECT EXPECTATIONS 2016-2017

General Overview:

Our performing groups meet once a week to learn and practice choreography to perform at various events throughout the year. As opportunities arise, we request you make your best effort to attend. Performing is fun and you get better at it with practice! Performing group focuses on jazz, lyrical, and hip hop styles. Your solo dance can be in any style of your choice.

Expectations:

We expect that everyone involved is committed to attending class. If you must be absent, please make every effort to learn any missed material or information from your classmates. You must attend the rehearsal the week of any performance to be eligible to perform. Director may exclude a dancer from any part of a dance due to absences.

Time Commitment:

- Rehearsals for Performing Group are on Tuesdays or possibly Thursday and/or Friday (Times will be determined after auditions).
- Students are required to be in at least one ballet technique class and one other style – jazz, tap, lyrical, etc.
- Students will attend one 30 minute private lesson each month.
- Performances throughout the year include:

 - Royals Gala (May)

Mandatory Events and Reasonable Excuse Policy:

Competition, convention, gala, showcase and recital are considered mandatory.

Retirement homes and festival performances have reasonable excuse policy. Our reasonable excuse policy allows for conflicting family events. Reasonable excuses must be submitted to the director in advance. Performers who are unable to make performances a priority will be dismissed.

Summer Intensive:

All Dance Project Members are to attend the summer intensive August 22-26 4:30-9:00pm \$150
Summer intensive will provide the first routine for the performing group repertoire.
